Lower Harbour Cruise 10 March 2013

Another beautiful day greeted our biggest turn out for Club sailing for some time. We had three each in the keeler and trailer yacht divisions for our cruise around Tauranga Harbour.

Start was off D mark and we would sail to the TYPBC and around the lower harbour and back to Omokoroa via Te Puna Channel. The wind - predicted as SE was mainly NE and light and patchy with the tide being low at around midday at Tauranga.

The members taking part in the Club Cruise were Janet and Tom Barratt in Wavedancer, Brendon Cooney and Murray Moon on Konini and a visiting Chico 30 in the keeler division.

The trailer yacht division welcomed back Keith Heron and Ace High, we conned Michael Coddington and his lady on Xena, a Monarch 17, and Alan and John on Piccaninny.

The cruise started at 11.46 off D mark and in light airs the fleet eased down tide. Ace High and Piccaninny led the fleet down to Rangiwae and W 12. In the early stages Xena, Konini, Wavedancer and the Chico were bunched. In the lower harbour, Chico and Wavedancer found a higher breeze and overtook Piccaninny but Ace High was away and clear. A mainsail traveller problem hit Piccaninny, and Wavedancer, who had been passed, repaid the compliment and was off again. The chase back up harbour was long and at the Te Puna channel all the leading four caught up together and as the finish loomed keelers and trailer yachts were neck and neck. the Chico crossed first followed by Ace High and equal third were Wavedancer and Piccaninny). Konini was fourth and Xena retired - a great sail spoilt by lack of breeze. Well done all.
